Emotional assessment : Some emotional disorders, such as depression, generalized anxiety disorder, obsessive compulsive disorder (OCD), or oppositional defiant disorder (ODD), often accompany ADHD. When a child shows signs of one of these conditions, an emotional assessment, completed by a mental health professional may be required.

The ADHD-RS-IV rating scale has been used as a screener for entry for preschool ADHD studies (Gopin et al., 2012; Nomura et al., 2012), to classify preschoolers as "high risk" or "low risk" of ADHD based on parent and teacher ratings (Berwind et al., 2005), and to assess parent perception of ADHD-related symptoms in the context of other problem behaviors (Kadesjo et al., 2003). Other researchers have adapted an 18-item list of symptoms to be more appropriate for the preschool ...

### Assessment of Attention in Preschoolers

ADHD symptoms are typically grouped into two major categories: inattention (the inability to stay focused) and hyperactivity-impulsivity (impulsive behaviors that are excessive and disruptive). The determination of ADHD is largely based on whether the behaviors are appropriate or inappropriate for the child's developmental age.

ADHD Evaluation If you or your child's teacher suspects your child may have ADHD, it's important to seek an evaluation. Early intervention may potentially prevent the emergence of further symptoms and secondary conditions such as anxiety or oppositional defiant behaviors. There isn't a specific lab test that is used to diagnose ADHD.

Physicians should evaluate for ADHD in children with behavioral concerns (e.g., inattention, hyperactivity, impulsivity, oppositionality) or poor academic progress using validated assessment tools with observers from several settings (home, school, community) and self-observation, if possible.

Summary and Purpose. Several forms of assessment are used to assess ADHD-characteristic behaviors, each with its own strengths and weakness. Although these assessment tools all are presumed to measure inattentive and hyperactive/impulsive behaviors, research has demonstrated low correlations between these measures.

Preschoolers and ADHD Children as young as four years old can be diagnosed with ADHD. Preschoolers with ADHD are more likely to have difficulties in daycare or school, including problems with peer relationships and learning. For preschoolers, behavioral treatments should be considered first and medication only when needed.

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
