I know it represents non-physician, non-selective debridement, but should we use it to report the services of staff who apply dressings that debride, such as enzymes, wet-to-moist, or wound cleaning with gauze?

Wound Repair Codes In 2020: What You Should Know ...

Documentation guidelines for CPT ® codes 11042—11047. Reported by depth of tissue that is removed and surface area of wound. Per CPT ® Assistant, may be reported for injuries, infections and chronic ulcers. For a single wound report the depth using the deepest level of tissue removed (multiple depths, one wound=one code).
