The first patient was a 7-year-old girl with intractable epilepsy due to a left parietal cortical dysplasia, who used the Atkins diet for a week in order to acclimate to the CKD. After 3 days, her seizures stopped, and she remained seizure-free for 3 years with continued dietary treatment (Kossoff et al., 2013).

Genetic counselors in our Department of Pediatrics are available to you to evaluate whether your child's epilepsy is caused by a genetic mutation and determine if there is a mutation that may affect other people in your family.

The etiologies of epilepsies are varied and multifactorial in most cases (Berg et al., 2010). Therefore,

investigation of the underlying causes of seizures will depend on the clinical context, in particular, the type of syndrome, age, types of seizures, associated diseases, presence or absence of progressive or static motor and cognitive dysfunction, among other factors.
