1. Add activity with 'No linked observation' - use this as the fastest and quickest way to add an activity without linking an ob (4-5 second load time). Write up links in the notes under "Reasons for this experience". 2. Linking to one observation: Add activity with with a linked observation (20 second load time) 3.
