For this issue, the following definition, adapted from Jameton, will be used: moral distress occurs when a clinician makes a moral judgment about a case in which he or she is involved and an external constraint makes it difficult or impossible to act on that judgment,

The Phenomenon of Moral Distress. In 1984, Andrew Jameton defined “moral distress” as a phenomenon in which one knows the right action to take, but is constrained from taking it. Moral distress is different from the classical ethical dilemma in which one recognizes that a

Framing the Issues: Moral Distress in Health Care

In his 1984 book *Nursing Practice: The Ethical Issues*, Jameton described moral distress as psychological disequilibrium, painful feelings that result from recognizing an ethically appropriate action but failing to take that action.

Addressing the root causes of moral distress, such as cultures of practice and economic constraints, is important and

laudable but not likely to achieve considerable change in the short to medium term. Acceptable change in the short to medium term may include broadening the scope of ethics consultation and other support to reduce and prevent burnout of service providers and attempt creative solutions within current constraints.
