The EU accession to the ECHR is one of the highest priorities of the Council of Europe and it constitutes a historical step for several reasons: As a result of acceding to the ECHR, the EU will be integrated into the fundamental rights protection system of the ECHR.

The accession of the European Union to the Convention denotes the process whereby the European Union will join the community of 47 European states which have entered into a legal undertaking to comply with the Convention and have agreed to supervision of their compliance by the European Court of Human Rights.

Accession of the EU - Information

The Treaty of Accession 1972 was the international agreement which provided for the accession of Denmark, Ireland, Norway and the United Kingdom to the European Communities. Norway did not ratify the treaty after it was rejected in a referendum held in September 1972. The treaty was ratified by Denmark, Ireland and the United Kingdom who became EC member states on 1 January 1973 when the treaty entered into force.

Accession Treaties - EUR-Lex

Negotiations are held with each candidate country to determine their ability to apply EU legislation (*acquis*) and examine their possible request for transition periods. In order to conduct the accession negotiations, EU legislation and standards are divided into 35 chapters which are negotiated one by one.

Accession of Montenegro to the European Union (EU) is on the current agenda for future enlargement of the EU. The State Union of Serbia and Montenegro started the process of Accession to the European Union in November 2005, when negotiations over a Stabilisation and Association Agreement began.

Steps towards joining The process of joining the EU (accession) broadly consists of 3 stages : When a country is ready it becomes an official candidate for membership – but this does not necessarily mean that formal negotiations have been opened.

European Commission - Enlargement - Treaty of accession. The treaty of accession is signed by the member states and the acceding country* once accession negotiations* have come to a close. Accession is not however automatic as the Treaty has to be ratified by the Member States and the acceding country.

The Accession of the United Kingdom to the European Communities - the collective term for the European Coal and Steel Community, the European Economic Community and the European Atomic Energy Community - took effect on 1 January 1973. This followed ratification of the Accession treaty which was signed in Brussels on 22 January 1972 by the Conservative prime minister Edward Heath, who had pursued the UK's application to the EEC since the late 1950s. Accession of the United Kingdom to the European ...

Accession is not automatic, since it depends on the adequate preparation of the applicant country concerned and on the EU's capacity to integrate the new member. There is thus a pre-accession period of varying length, during which the candidate country adapts its institutions, standards and infrastructure to enable it to meet its obligations as a member state.

The European Union (EU) has expanded a number of times throughout its history by way of the accession of new member states to the Union. To join the EU, a state needs to fulfil economic and political conditions called the Copenhagen criteria (after the Copenhagen summit in June 1993), which require a stable democratic government that respects the rule of law, and its corresponding freedoms and institutions.

European Commission - Enlargement - Accession negotiations Negotiations take place in intergovernmental conferences between member states and the candidate country. They relate to the conditions under which the country will be admitted to the EU and focus on the adoption and implementation of the EU's body of law (the *acquis**).

Turkey is negotiating its accession to the European Union (EU) as a member state, following its application accede to the European Economic Community, the predecessor of the EU, on 14 April 1987. After the ten founding members, Turkey was one of the first countries to become a member of the Council of Europe in 1949.
