Prior to the abolition of the priority need test, only those assessed as homeless (or threatened with homelessness) and in priority need would have proceeded to the intentionality test. However, following abolition, all those assessed as homeless (or threatened with homelessness) are tested for intentionality.

The Homelessness (Abolition of Priority Need Test) (Scotland) Order 2012 abolished the priority need test for homeless households. As a result, from 31st December 2012, all unintentionally homeless households are now entitled to settled accommodation.

What is priority need? Under the Welsh homelessness legislation, people who are in certain 'priority need' groups have an enhanced right to accommodation. This amended the Housing (Scotland) Act 1987 which defines the rights of homeless people and was enshrined in law in 2012 with the Homeless (Abolition of Priority Need Test) (Scotland) Order 2012. In 2012 the Scottish Parliament also passed secondary legislation on housing support regulations, requiring local authorities to assess the housing support needs of homeless applicants.

The Homelessness etc. (Scotland) Act 2003 is more long-term in scope, notably introducing a phasing out of the distinction between priority and non-priority applications. The ultimate aim of the Act was to ensure that everyone assessed as being unintentionally homeless was entitled to settled accommodation from 31st December 2012.

However, homelessness is far from fixed. The best legal framework is only as good as the way it provides people with the help they need. Across the country services are uneven. 10,000 people are in temporary accommodation: the right to a home is not the same as getting a home.

The effect of the abolition of the priority need test will be to place a duty on local authorities to provide permanent accommodation to all households that are unintentionally homeless in Scotland. The abolition of the priority need test will also cover households that are threatened with homelessness.
